BATTLE TASKS

- Coordinate shared and exclusive resources
 - + Fire and Rescue
 - + Law Enforcement
 - + Medical
- Coordinate Public Affairs activities
- Create legal basis for cooperation with MOA/MOU's
- Train leaders for interagency incident command
- Exercise the “Partnership”

Commanders exercise, evaluate, and assess WMD & AT/FP plans

BATTLE TASKS

- Institute an AT/FP exercise program that tests the installation's capability to respond to the entire spectrum of AT/FP threats, including a WMD incident.
- Include local, state, and federal agencies
- Conduct AAR's at all levels and provide feedback to the AT/FP Committee

Commanders ensure WMD First Responder and Consequence Management capabilities

BATTLE TASKS

- Leverage Domestic Preparedness Program
- Plan for various WMD scenarios
- Identify, equip, and train First Responders
- Ensure external interoperable equipment and procedures
- Establish interagency communications
