Mr. John B. Nerger, SES **EXECUTIVE DEPUTY TO THE COMMANDING GENERAL**



Mr. John B. Nerger assumed the role of Executive Deputy to the Commanding General of the Army Materiel Command July 15, 2011.

As the executive deputy to the commanding general, Mr. Nerger is responsible for materiel life cycle management, acquisition support, personnel and resource management, industrial base operations, enterprise integration and provision of research and development, and science and technology for a globally reaching command with more than 70,000 personnel working worldwide at 155 locations globally and all 50 states.

Mr. Nerger was selected for the Senior Executive Service in July 2000.

From July 2008 to May 2011, he served as the Executive Director of the U.S. Army Installation Management Command, where he directed the multi-disciplinary management of facilities, programs, services and infrastructure for 110 Army installations.

From October 2004 to July 2008, he was the Deputy Chief of Staff, G-1/4, personnel and logistics, for U.S. Army Training and Doctrine Command at Fort Monroe, Va. From July 2000 to October 2004, he was Director of Facilities, Housing, and Environment on the Army Staff responsible for a 3 billion dollar global capital investment program.

From 1998 to 2000 he served as Director of Facilities & Housing, Office Assistant Chief of Staff for Installation Management in Washington, DC.

Prior to that he was the deputy chief of Base Realignment and Closure for the Assistant Chief of Staff for Installation Management in Washington, DC from 1995 to 1998, and the Deputy Director of the Army Basing Study Group at the Office of the Chief of Staff of the Army, Washington, DC from 1990 to 1995. He served as a planner in the Office of the Assistant Chief of Engineers at Headquarters Department of the Army in Washington, DC from 1988 to 1990.

Prior to that, from 1985 to 1988 he worked as an analyst in the Program Analysis and Evaluation, Office of the Chief of Staff of the Army, Washington, DC. From 1984-1985 he served as chief, Financial Management, Joint Chiefs of Staff, Washington, DC.

Prior to that, he served as an analyst, Assistant Chief of Engineers, Headquarters Department of the Army, Washington, DC. Mr. Nerger began his career in government service in 1980 as a Management Assistant for the Office Chief of Naval Operations, Department of the Navy in Arlington Va. Mr. Nerger has a master's degree in Public Administration from the University of Virginia, Charlottesville, Va.; and a bachelor's degree in English from Northwestern University, Evanston, Ill. He is a 1994 U.S. Army War College graduate.
