## **Chief Warrant Officer 5 Darren L. Cook** **AMC CHIEF WARRANT OFFICER**

CW5 Darren L. Cook currently serves as the Army Materiel Command (AMC) Command Chief Warrant Officer (CCWO). The CCWO serves as the senior warrant officer of the command and advises the CG and staff on logistics readiness, warrant officer professional development and utilization. The CCWO represents AMC in the execution of its mission with its strategic partners and subordinate commands. Additionally, the CCWO communicates with soldiers throughout the Army, National Guard and Army Reserve to ensure their concerns and recommendations are considered in decisions that will impact their readiness posture. CW5 Cook previously served as the Force Sustainment Warrant Officer Branch Chief, Human Resources Command where he was responsible for the career management of over 6,200 Warrant Officers in the active Army and Army Reserve.



Chief Cook is a native of Boligee, Alabama. He enlisted in the Army as a Power Generation Equipment Repairer in 1984 and attended Basic Combat Training at Fort McClellan, Alabama, and Advanced Individual Training at Fort Belvoir, Virginia. CW5 Cook spent more than seven years as a noncommissioned before appointment as a Warrant Officer in 1995. Chief Cook has held a variety of logistic positions over his 31 year career. His assignments include the 7th Army Training Command, Grafenwoehr, Germany; 1st Armored Division, Nurnberg and Wiesbaden, Germany; 7th Signal Command, Fort Gordon, Georgia.; 2nd Infantry Division, Camps Stanley and LaGuardia, Korea; 36th Engineer Group, Fort Benning, Georgia; 101st Airborne Division, Fort Campbell, Kentucky; 18th Engineer Brigade, Hanau, Germany; 405th Army Field Support Brigade, Schweinfurt, Germany; Deputy Chief of Staff G-4, Headquarters Department of the Army and Officer Personnel Management Division, Human Resources Command, Fort Knox Kentucky. Chief Cook deployed in support of Operation Desert Shield/ Desert Storm, Operation Restore Hope (Nicaragua), Operation Enduring Freedom and Operation Iraqi Freedom.

CW5 Cook is a graduate of the Warrant Officer Basic, Advanced, Intermediate Level and Senior Service Education. He holds several logistics certifications and a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration. His awards and decorations include the Bronze Star with two oak leaf clusters; the Meritorious Service Medal with three oak leaf clusters; Army Commendation Medal with silver leaf cluster; Army Achievement Medal with three oak leaf clusters; Humanitarian Service Medal; Joint, Meritorious & Superior Unit Awards, Army Staff Badge, and the Order of Samuel Sharpe.
