MEMORANDUM FOR SEE DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: Designation as the Single Manager for Conventional Ammunition (SMCA) Executor and Delegation of Authority for SMCA Execution and Limited Section 806 Authority

1. Department of Defense Directive (DoDD) 5160.65 assigns the SMCA mission within the Department of Defense to the Secretary of the Army. On 25 June 2010, the Secretary of the Army delegated authority for the performance of the functions outlined in the DoDD 5160.65 and Section 806 to the Assistant Secretary of the Army (Acquisition, Logistics and Technology) (ASA(ALT)) until 30 September 2014, (enclosure) and that delegation includes the authority to redelegate or subdelegate the authorities outlined in Department of Defense Instruction 5160.68.
2. The ASA(ALT) retains responsibility for issuing policy for, and providing oversight of, SMCA functions and Section 806 authority. I hereby designate the Program Executive Officer, Ammunition (PEO Ammo) as the SMCA Executor and delegate authorities not specifically retained by the ASA(ALT) to the PEO Ammo.
3. Section 806 of the Strom Thurmond National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 1999 vests the SMCA with authority to restrict the procurement of conventional ammunition to sources within the National Technology and Industrial Base in accordance with Title 10, United States Code, Section 2304(c). I hereby delegate limited Section 806 authority to the PEO Ammo for the purpose of making Section 806 Determinations as described in this delegation of authority.
4. This delegation provides the PEO Ammo with the authority to sign Section 806 Determinations under appropriate circumstances, but it does not authorize the PEO Ammo to direct anyone other than PEO Ammo reportable program managers to change the approach to competition for a particular procurement. If the PEO Ammo disagrees with a planned approach to competition and cannot resolve the issues at his/her level, he/she will follow the established provisions to present information to the ASA(ALT) for a decision.
5. The authorities delegated by this memorandum may not be redelegated or subdelegated.

6. The delegations and authorities conferred by this delegation shall remain in effect through 30 September 2014, unless sooner rescinded in writing. The delegation of authority issued by this office, dated 8 February 2006, subject: Designation as the SMCA Executor and Delegation of Authority for SMCA Execution and Section 806, Strom Thurmond National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 1999, is hereby rescinded.
