




ARO Mission & Functions

- **As an AMC Special Staff office...**
 - ❖ Provide advice, assistance & expertise on matters pertaining to or impacting upon USAR
 - ❖ Represent USAR interests within AMC
- **Tasks:**
 - ❖ USAR advice, assistance & liaison
 - ❖ Administer TTAD, ADSW, PSRC
 - ❖ Lead AMC AC/RC Integration
 - ❖ Train RC forces at AMC facilities
 - ❖ Manage AMC IMAs
 - ❖ Monitor USAR logistics interests
 - ❖ Staff lead for RFPB, RCCC & ARFPC
 - ❖ Support GO RCPC

Individual Mobilization Augmentees (IMAs)


- **Pre-trained augmentation for war/crisis**



Collective Training

- **Exercise GOLDEN CARGO:**
RC forces move BRAC-displaced materiel
- **Exercise GOLDEN KASTLE:**
RC engineer forces support AMC facilities
- **Exercise GOLDEN ARGOSY:**
RC forces COSIS of afloat prepo stocks
- **Overseas Deployment Training (ODT):**
RC unit support to OCONUS prepositioned stocks
- **RC Training:**
Hands-on enhancement/ sustainment tng in Depots/Plants
- **HTRTS-M (TYAD):**
Accredited sustainment / transition training; electronics and power generation repair

● Authorizations allocated AMC MSCs

- ❖ MSCs allocate to subordinates
- ❖ Mob documents currently being updated for FY 00 implementation

● Reorg: authorizations follow workload



Temp Tours of Active Duty

- **Temp soldier from RC for special AC need**
 - ❖ Uniformed equivalent of “Kelly Temp Help”
 - ❖ Duration 30-179 days
- **Approved purposes (per AR 135-200):**
 - ❖ Special projects; surge need
 - ❖ Not staff augmentation; manpower shortage
- **Costs incurred:**
 - ❖ HQDA pays salary & benefits
 - ❖ Requesting agency pays travel/per diem
- **Success varies**
 - ❖ FY 98 = 60+ requests; 34 tours; 13.8 man-years
 - ❖ FY 99 = 27 requests; 19 tours; 5.37 man-years



RC Unit Training

AMC RC TNG POLICY

- Support RC Training
- Share logistics expertise
- Share costs and benefits
- Good training ***and*** good business

- **METL training *and* supporting AMC**
 - ❖ Units ... *not* individuals
- **AMC requirements built annually**
 - ❖ FY 01 submitted Mar 99 to USAR & ARNG
 - ❖ “Out of cycle” at any time, but
- **AMC’s best success is C² exercises**
 - ❖ GOLDEN CARGO, KASTLE, ARGOSY
- **Sharing both costs & benefits**
 - ❖ Using RC units not “free”
 - ❖ Must make business sense to AMC

Emerging Crisis Requirements

- **RC Units for surge materiel out-load**
 - ❖ Early mobilization (ILO hire/contract)
 - ❖ RC already organized, trained & equipped
- **No additional Army force structure**
 - ❖ Use early only what exists
 - ❖ Further deployment to TO after surge
- **Total 14 units @ 6 locations (30-179 days)**
 - ❖ ANAD: 1 OD CO (AMMO)
 - ❖ MCAAP: 4 TC CO (CT, PLS, MT, RAIL)
- **FORSCOM identified 12 units**
- **Implication for Annual Training (AT)**
