- a. This Order reorganizes LOGSA to include the mission, functions, and resources from U.S. Army Materiel Command-Europe (AMC-EUROPE), XX (W4JMAA).
 - b. Redesignates U.S. Army Materiel Command-Europe as the U.S. Army Materiel Command Logistics Support Element-Europe (LSE-Europe).
 - c. Rescinds, effective this date, PO 70-1, 11 March 1998, effective 15 March 1998, which established the U.S. Army Materiel Command Field Support Activity on a Provisional basis.

Assigned to: Headquarters, U.S. Army Materiel Command (AMC), X2 (WOGWAA).

Mission: To provide logistics information and management support to the Department of the Army, Department of Defense, and other services in the broad areas of Logistics mission readiness and assistance; integrated logistics support; logistics and materiel distribution management, procedures and systems; packaging, storage, and containerization policy and procedures; and Army cataloging policy, policy, operations, data management, and distribution. The mission for LSE-CONUS, LSE-Far East, and LSE-Europe is to serve as AMC central point of contact within the assigned geographic area; provides logistics support during mobilization, hostilities, and other contingencies; furnishes logistics intelligence feedback to AMC organizations and field units; administers training and development program for logistics assistance representatives and provides sustainment training of AMC fielded equipment; and monitor all AMC sponsored contractor field operations in the area of responsibility. Additional mission for LSE-Europe is to operate materiel staging and fielding sites in Theater to provide for the receipt, storage, deprocessing, and issuance of new equipment and to apply MWOs on equipment for USAREUR activities.
