The Natick RDEC and the Edgewood RDEC will be redesignated the U.S. Army Edgewood and Natick Research, Development and Engineering Center and assigned the W1D1AA with two locations. Discontinue XAW1DGAA, Edgewood RDEC (mission, functions and resources merged with W1D1AA). Command and control of the U.S. Army Surety Field Activity (mission, functions, and resources merged with XAW4MLAA). Discontinue X3W2EWAA 1 Oct 99.
