

MEMORANDUM FOR SEE DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: Use of Corporate Contracts -- Implementing Instructions

1. Reference memorandum, AMCRDA-AC, 24 Oct 00, subject: Use of Corporate Contracts.
2. The referenced memorandum stated the Commanding General's policy that AMC contract instruments be used in the execution of AMC's mission. The policy applies only to fulfilling AMC's core mission requirements in the area of maintenance of weapon systems and combat support equipment.
3. This command must have a suite of broad, flexible contracts to augment the Army's organic logistics sustainment capability. We must be able to provide the full range of maintenance services wherever the Army goes. Cost effective, responsive, corporate contracts are essential to AMC's ability to execute our mission. Each major subordinate command will submit a time phased action plan to me within 60 days of this memorandum which outlines your plans for establishing the appropriate contract vehicles for your commodity areas.
