Ms. Baker has been assigned as the Principal Deputy G-3 (Operations), U.S. Army Materiel Command (AMC) since January 2003. She provides direction, oversight, managerial guidance and supervision of the Deputies for Current Operations, Support Operations, Industrial Operations, Enterprise Integration, Future Operations and the Business Solutions Directorate. This includes the operations, plans, force protection, maintenance, sustainment, materiel management, ammunition, Single Stock Fund, Chemical/Biological, industrial base, strategic planning, logistics Transformation and life cycle management mission areas. She also functions as the Deputy for Army Logistics Enterprise Integration, responsible for functionally integrating logistics business processes and associated automation system modernization efforts Army-wide.



In addition to holding a Bachelor of Arts degree in Political Science from New Mexico State University and a Master of Science from the National Defense University, Ms. Baker is a graduate of the Army Management Staff College, the Industrial College of the Armed Forces and the DoD Senior Acquisition Course.

Following completion of her undergraduate studies, she served as a Materiel Management intern for the U.S. Air Force. Her Army career assignments range from positions in logistics management to resource and program management. She served as the Chief of an installation Manpower and Management Analysis Division, as a Special Assistant to the Installation Commander (Vint Hill Farms Station) and as a liaison to the National Security Agency. At CECOM's Intelligence Materiel Management Center, Ms. Baker served as the Project Leader for the Communications Restoral System, as the Director of a Logistics Weapons Systems organization, and as the Director of the Center's Business Management operations. She served in the Pentagon as a Staff Officer, Plans and Programs Division, Office of the Deputy Chief of Staff, G-2, and as a Logistics Management Specialist, Supply and Maintenance Directorate, Office of the Deputy Chief of Staff, G-4.

Ms. Baker served as the Single Stock Fund Program Director from January 1998 through 15 July 2002. Under her leadership, the Single Stock Fund initiative transitioned from concept development to initial operating capability in 28 months and was selected as the DoD winning entrant for the Worldwide Supply Chain Council 2001 Excellence Award. Ms. Baker was then reassigned as the Deputy G-3 for Enterprise Integration, HQ AMC. In this capacity, she was responsible for functionally integrating logistics business processes and associated automation systems across the Army.

She has received numerous honors and awards for her professional accomplishments including the Meritorious Civilian Service Award and Commander's Awards for Civilian Service. She has contributed to technical reports and journal articles about aspects of business process reengineering.
