Command Sergeant Major Alberto Delgado assumed duties as the 17th Command Sergeant Major of U.S. Army Materiel Command July 23, 2020. As AMC's Command Sergeant Major, Delgado serves as the Commanding General's personal adviser on all enlisted-related matters, primarily focused on the quality of life for Soldiers, Civilians and Families across the command as well as the training of the Noncommissioned Officer Corps and Soldiers.

CSM Delgado, a New York City native, enlisted in the New York Army National Guard Aug. 18, 1987, attending One Station Unit Training as a Field Artillery Cannon Crewmember at Fort Sill, Oklahoma. CSM Delgado entered active duty January 19, 1989, and reclassified as a 76C – PLL Tamm's clerk in February 1993.
