This has been a busy week (already) as DoD, Army and AMC leaders continue to assess our worldwide situation and update guidance accordingly.

You have likely seen that DoD extended the stop-movement order through 30 June. While the order impacts PCS moves and TDY travel for service members and DoD civilians, and personal leave for service members, the new guidance adds procedures and exceptions for some critical categories of travel to resume. I encourage you to take the time to read the order, understand the guidance, and work your questions through your chain of command.
