Joint Munitions Command (JMC), headquartered in Illinois at Rock Island Arsenal, provides the Joint Forces with ready, reliable, lethal munitions to sustain worldwide readiness. JMC manages a complex munitions enterprise comprised of installations and depots where conventional munitions are produced, stored, distributed and demilitarized.

JMC storage and distribution facilities ensure the availability of a ready and reliable munitions stockpile through optimizing the receipt, storage and issue of training and combat munitions. Every bullet, bomb and grenade Warfighters use in training and combat is managed by JMC.

JMC demilitarization facilities safely and securely disable, decontaminate and destroy excess, outdated and inoperable ammunition.

JMC chemical commands enhance national security by securely storing the remaining U.S. chemical warfare materiel stockpiles, while protecting the workforce, the public and the environment.

JMC employs 19 military personnel, more than 5,400 Army civilian personnel and more than 5,900 contractors nationwide, throughout the organic industrial base. JMC's processes provide for the efficient delivery of ammunition at the right place and time to support global operations. JMC positions munitions around the world to facilitate rapid transition to armed conflict and to support Combatant Commander requirements.
